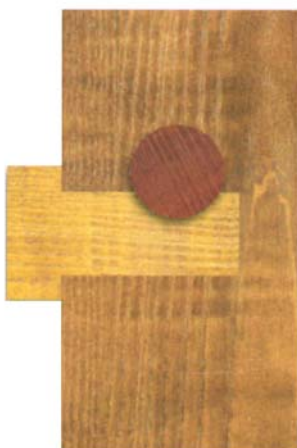


Craftsmanship

We predominantly use North American Ash hardwood and North American Hickory hardwood in all of our products. These woods are chosen for their light weight and extraordinary durability, couple with their overall beauty once crafted and finished.

Our construction methods use no glue, but instead combine multiple pressure clamping, precisely machined components, and the woods natural characteristics to manipulate the expansion and swelling of interlocking joints (see diagram below).



All components are machined and hand-sanded for a smooth uniform surface. Every hardwood surface has its own personality and is distinctive in every way.

Our **WEATHERMASTER FINISH** has been field tested throughout the eastern and southern United States and has proven to be a leader in outdoor wood furniture protection. Developed in Conjunction with the people who make **RUSTOLEUM**, this unique multipart finish includes:

UV inhibitors to slow sun damage

Mildew resistance to inhibit the growth of mildew

Urethane properties to provide a strong exterior coating

We suggest that you protect your furniture from these elements and be aware that constant exposure to the elements will accelerate weathering of your furniture.
